

## Slack Water Constants for Anglesey & the Lleyn Peninsula

All times relate to Liverpool Tidal times

Underlining refers to preferred tides    - = before & + = after High or Low water

<u>Puffin Island</u>	-40 to +30 mins	<u>HW/LW</u>
<u>North Coast</u>		
Off-shore (eg Coal Rock)	-1 ½ hr	<u>LW / HW</u>
Coastal Waters (eg West Mouse)	-45min	<u>LW / HW</u>
On SPRING tides slack occurs 15 -20 mins earlier		
East Platters (Skerries)	-1 ¼ to -1 ½ hr	LW
Holyhead	-½ to -1 hr	LW / <u>HW</u>
“Fangs”	+/- 1-2 hr	LW / <u>HW</u>
Rhoscolyn Beacons	-3 hr	LW
SW Coast Anglesey	-3 hr	LW / HW
Caernarfon	-1 ½ hr	LW / HW
N coast Lleyn	-2 ½ hr	LW / HW
Maen Nellt	-2 -3 hr	LW / HW
Bardsey Sound	-1 ¾	LW
Seagull Island	-3 hr	LW
St Tudwalls Island	-3 ½ hr	LW / HW
Bardsey Island (NW side)	- ½ to -1 hr	LW
Bardsey Island (SW side)	- ½ hr	LW
Bardsey Island (SE side)	-1 hr	LW
Menai Strait (Ynys y Moch)	-2 ½	LW
Menai Strait (Pwll Fanog)	-2 ½	LW
Menai Strait (Port Dinorwic)	-3 hr	LW
